 Create simple repeating patterns using objects around the home

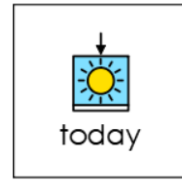

 Visit a local park to play and take turns

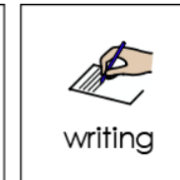

 Have a daily schedule for home and point out things that happened 'yesterday' or 'last week'



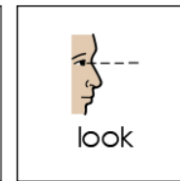
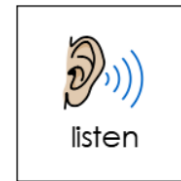
